The Award for Outstanding Character and Integrity was established in 2014 by the family of Gerald E. Miller in recognition of his life. The award in the amount of \$500 is offered through the Girard School District (GSD) Foundation. All graduating seniors are eligible to apply.

Determination of the award recipient will be done by a committee from the GSD Foundation in conjunction with members of the Miller family. All seniors applying are requested to write an essay (no min./max. length required) that describes:

What Outstanding Character and Integrity means to me, and how I exemplify these characteristics in my daily life.

The application, essay, and at least one letter of reference must be submitted to the Girard High School office by May 4, 2018.

Requirements:

- Must be a senior who will graduate from Girard High School this year.
- Must be attending a post-secondary educational institution (college, university, trade school, etc.) or entering a US Service Branch.
- Must show proof of acceptance into a school of higher education (acceptance letter, tuition bill, etc.) or US Service Branch.
- No minimum GPA requirement.
- Must be actively involved in extracurricular or community activities.
- Must include at least one letter of reference from a GSD Faculty member, GSD Administrator, or a local clergy, community or business leader.
