Why do you think you deserve this scholarship? Be sure to include specific instances of how you learned more effective ways of building strong academic skills and personal work habits to achieve the goal of post-secondary education.

The application and essay must be submitted to the Girard High School office by **Monday, April 26, 2021.**

Requirements:

- Must be a senior who will graduate from Girard High School this year.
- Must be attending some type of higher education institution or technical school.
- Must submit one letter of recommendation from a non-family member.
- Must submit application, essay, letter, and proof of post-secondary plans to the Girard High School office by April 26, 2021.
